#### Why is OA Publication important?

Publishing via OA using APCs (Article Processing Charges) means that research outputs are immediately available online, and not behind paywalls. By prioritising OA publishing the Technological Education sector are ensuring that industry, educators and the public can discover and utilise new knowledge on a global scale.



#### **Number of Publications**


Through membership of IReL, the national e-resources purchasing consortium, NTUTORR funding has helped Libraries gain access to 6 new Transformative Agreements.

This has enabled the sector to offer additional routes to openly disseminate research outputs.
